Crisis Support - Students facing stressful or emotional issues have 24/7/365 access to prompt In-the-moment services. Beginning with your first toll-free call, our licensed specialists will listen carefully to assess your needs.



Web-Based Services - Our website, LiveAndWorkWell.com, provides students with confidential support for life's challenges. It offers health risk assessments, health/fitness calculators and other resources.
