

# 2023–2024 Student Health Insurance Plan for University of Richmond

### Who is eligible to enroll?

All international students on non-immigrant visas at the University of Richmond, regardless of credit hours taken, and visiting scholars are required to purchase this plan on a mandatory basis.

All degree seeking undergraduate students who are registered for and taking three and a half or more units, and all degree seeking graduate students who are registered for and taking nine or more credit hours are automatically enrolled in the insurance plan at registration and the premium for coverage added to their tuition billing, unless proof of comparable coverage is furnished.

Eligible students who do enroll may also insure their Dependents. Eligible Dependents are the student's legal spouse and dependent children under 26 years of age.

The student (Named Insured, as defined in the Certificate) must actively attend classes for at least the first 31 days after the date for which coverage is purchased. Home study, correspondence, and online courses do not fulfill the eligibility requirements that the student actively attend classes. The Company maintains its right to investigate eligibility or student status and attendance records to verify that the Policy eligibility requirements have been met. If and whenever the Company discovers that the Policy eligibility requirements have not been met, its only obligation is refund of premium.

The eligibility date for Dependents of the Named Insured shall be determined in accordance with the following:

- 1. If a Named Insured has Dependents on the date he or she is eligible for insurance.
- 2. If a Named Insured acquires a Dependent after the Effective Date, such Dependent becomes eligible:
  - a. On the date the Named Insured acquires a legal spouse.
  - b. On the date the Named Insured acquires a dependent child who is within the limits of a dependent child set forth in the Definitions section of the Certificate.

Dependent eligibility expires concurrently with that of the Named Insured.

Please read the certificate of coverage to determine whether this plan is right before you enroll. The certificate of coverage provides details of the coverage including benefits, exclusions, and reductions or limitations and the terms under which the coverage may be continued in force. This plan is underwritten by UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company and is based on policy number 2023-1443-1. The Policy is a Non-Renewable One-Year Term Policy.

### **Exclusions and Limitations**

No benefits will be paid for: a) loss or expense caused by, contributed to, or resulting from; or b) treatment, services or supplies for, at, or related to any of the following:

- 1. Addiction, such as:
  - Caffeine addiction.
  - Non-chemical addiction, such as: gambling, sexual, spending, shopping, working and religious.
  - Codependency.

This exclusion does not apply to conditions classified as a Mental Illness or Substance Use Disorder in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of the American Psychiatric Association.

2. Behavioral problems. Developmental delay or disorder or intellectual disability. Learning disabilities. Parent-child problems.

This exclusion does not apply to conditions classified as a Mental Illness or Substance Use Disorder in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of the American Psychiatric Association.

- 3. Biofeedback.
- 4. Cosmetic procedures, except as specifically provided in the Policy for Reconstructive Procedures.
- 5. Custodial Care.
  - Care provided in: rest homes, health resorts, homes for the aged, halfway houses, college infirmaries or places mainly for domiciliary or Custodial Care.
  - Extended care in treatment or substance use facilities for domiciliary or Custodial Care.
- 6. Dental treatment, except:
  - As provided in the Dental Treatment benefit.
  - As specifically provided in the Schedule of Benefits.
  - This exclusion does not apply to benefits specifically provided in Pediatric Dental Services.
- 7. Elective Surgery or Elective Treatment as defined in the Policy.

  - Therapeutic devices or appliances, including: support garments and other non-medical substances, regardless of intended use, except as specifically provided in the Policy.
  - Immunization agents, except as specifically provided in the Policy.
  - Drugs labeled, "Caution limited by federal law to investigational use" or experimental drugs.
  - Products used for cosmetic purposes.
  - Drugs used to treat or cure baldness. Anabolic steroids used for body building.
  - Anorectics drugs used for the purpose of weight control.
  - Fertility agents.
  - Growth hormones.
- Refills in excess of the number specified or dispensed after one (1) year of date of the prescription.
- 19. Reproductive services for the following:
  - Procreative counseling.
  - Genetic counseling and genetic testing, except as specifically provided in Genetic Testing.
  - Cryopreservation of reproductive materials. Storage of reproductive materials.
  - Infertility treatment (male or female), including any services or supplies rendered for the purpose or with the intent of inducing conception, except to diagnose or treat the underlying cause of the infertility.
  - Premarital examinations.
  - Reversal of sterilization procedures, except as specifically provided in the Policy under Sterilization.
  - Impotence, organic or otherwise.
- 20. Research or examinations relating to research studies, or any treatment for which the patient or the patient's representative must sign an informed consent document identifying the treatment in which the patient is to participate as a research study or clinical research study, except as specifically provided in the Benefits for Clinical Trials for Treatment Studies on Cancer.
- 21. Routine eye examinations. Eye refractions. Eyeglasses. Contact lenses. Prescriptions or fitting of eyeglasses or contact lenses. Vision correction surgery. Treatment for visual defects and problems. This exclusion does not apply as follows:
  - When due to a covered Injury or disease process.
  - To benefits specifically provided in Pediatric Vision Services.
  - To eyeglasses or contact lenses as described under Vision Correction in the Policy.
  - To benefits specifically provided in the Schedule of Benefits.
- 22. Routine Adopted or Newborn Child Care and well-baby nursery and related Physician charge, except as specifically provided in the Policy.
- 23. Services provided normally without charge by the Health Service of the Policyholder. Services covered or provided by the student health fee.
- 24. Nasal and sinus surgery, except for treatment of a covered Injury or treatment of chronic sinusitis. This exclusion does not apply to:
  - Maxillary or mandibular frenectomy when not related to a dental procedure.
  - Alveolectomy related to tooth extraction.
  - Orthognathic surgery required to attain functional capacity.
  - Surgical services on the hard or soft tissue of the mouth for purposes not related to treat or help teeth and supporting structures.
  - Treatment of cleft lip, cleft palate, or ectodermal dysplasia.
- 25. Naturopathic services.
- 26. Stand-alone multi-disciplinary smoking cessation programs. These are programs that usually include health care providers specializing in smoking cessation and may include a psychologist, social worker or other licensed or certified professional.
- 27. Surgical breast reduction, breast augmentation, breast implants or breast prosthetic devices, or gynecomastia, except as specifically provided in the Policy.
- 28. Treatment in a Government hospital, unless there is a legal obligation for the Insured Person to pay for such treatment.
- 29. War or any act of war, declared or undeclared; or while in the armed forces of any country (a pro-rata premium will be refunded upon request for such period not covered).
- 30. Weight management. Weight reduction. Nutrition programs. Treatment for obesity (except morbid obesity). Surgery for removal of excess skin or fat. This exclusion does not apply to benefits specifically provided in the Schedule of Benefits.
